Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

- Development of professional techniques and skills that promote quality early childhood education
- Develop and maintain cooperative and respectful relationships
- Supervision and management of young children
- Maintain complete and accurate records.
- Coordinate and collaborate with other WV employees, volunteers, parents & donors
- Maintain classroom and general building appearance
- Maintain compliance with regulatory agencies
- Works collaboratively and cooperatively with other employees to achieve the Warren Village mission

Qualifications:

Preferred qualifications:

- Bachelor's or Associate's degree in Early Childhood Education, child development, elementary education, or early childhood special education or a Bachelor's degree in an unrelated field with at least 36 college credit hours in early childhood education or a related field.
- 3+ years of experience working with children.
- Bilingual and/or experience with culturally diverse environment.
- Prior experience successfully applying the Conscious Discipline model.

Minimum qualifications:

- Meet Colorado State Licensing and NAEYC educational qualification standards. Associate's degree in early childhood education, child development, elementary education, or early childhood special education with at least one course being an introduction to early childhood education or guidance strategies, or equivalency (at least 60 college/university credits with at least 30 college credits in early childhood education, child development, elementary education, or early childhood education).
- a related field or unrelated field with a minimum of two classes in Early Childhood Education
- 3 years of experience working with children ages infancy through five, including preparing TGS and lesson planning.
- Two years computer experience, including Microsoft programs.
- Ability to communicate effectively with residents, staff, volunteers, and other community representatives.
- Ability to lift at least 40 pounds.
- Must be able to assume postures in low levels to allow physical and visual contact with children, see and hear well enough to keep children safe, and engage in physical activity with children.
- CPR and First Aid Certification or willingness to obtain.
- Knowledgeable about the Colorado Department of Human Services Licensing Regulations, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Regulations, and the Denver First Department Regulations that govern childcare facilities.
- Ability to work the evenings or weekends when requested.
- Must be committed to Warren Village's mission and culture.
