We provide families with the space and resources to achieve economic mobility and well-being. Due to Warren Village's reputation for high quality services, Warren Village was invited to provide a wide range of programs onsite at Ivy Crossing, a 1,000+ unit, market rate workforce housing apartment complex in southeast Denver owned by BMC Investments and FCP. Warren Village at Ivy Crossing provides a wide range of supportive services including Mobility Mentoring® Economic Mobility Coaching, resource referrals, a food pantry, Kids' Club, and community events.

RESOURCE REFERRALS

Warren Village at Ivy Crossing staff can provide referrals to resources in the community to residents. These resources assist residents in keeping safe and stable housing.



GOAL SETTING & ECONOMIC MOBILITY

Warren Village at Ivy Crossing staff work with interested residents to set, plan, reach, and sustain goals through the Mobility Mentoring® economic mobility coaching program.



KIDS' CLUB

Kids' Club is a holistic program that includes activities that enhance social, emotional, intellectual, physical, and creative health. Children between the ages of 5 and 14 are welcome.



FOOD PANTRY

Our food pantry is stocked through community partnerships and aims to alleviate some of the pressure of the rising cost of food and basic needs. The food pantry is open to all residents of Ivy Crossing.
