Dr. Lockspeiser is an Associate Professor in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Colorado. She grew up in Denver Colorado and then attended Stanford University where she obtained a BA in psychology with honors. She went on to attend the University of California, San Francisco for medical school. In between her third and fourth year of medical school she completed a year-long fellowship in medical education at UCSF that provided her with a broad exposure to medical education. She stayed at UCSF for her pediatric residency and chief residency.

After finishing her training at UCSF, Dr. Lockspeiser took a position as an assistant professor of pediatrics at the University of Colorado where she currently works. As a general pediatrician, she works mostly in the Child Health Clinic at Children's Hospital Colorado where she supervises medical students and residents. In addition to her work as a general pediatrician she is very involved in educational scholarship and leadership. Dr. Lockspeiser is currently the Director of Electives for the School of Medicine and the Medical Director of the Child Health Associate Physician Assistant Program. She recently completed a master's degree in Health Professions Education from the University of Illinois, Chicago.
